Clark Howard and Cox Enterprises Jumpstart 2009 Atlanta Habitat for Humanity Home Building by Sponsoring Five Houses

One Atlanta Habitat house is dedicated to the memory of Millard Fuller and to the honor of Linda Fuller, co-founders of Habitat for Humanity International

(Atlanta, GA—March 16, 2009) — As one of the city of Atlanta's most productive affordable housing builders, Atlanta Habitat depends upon collaborations and generous sponsors to support its work of "building a better Atlanta, one home at a time." Thanks to supportive donors like consumer advocate Clark Howard and his wife, Lane, and Cox Enterprises companies, affordable, quality, energy-efficient houses for five families jumpstarted Atlanta Habitat's construction in early 2009.

Atlanta Habitat dedicates four of the houses sponsored by these generous supporters in the Lakewood Commons neighborhood of southeast Atlanta on March 21 at 1:00 PM. In a very special recognition, one Clark Howard-sponsored home will be dedicated to the memory of Millard Fuller and in honor of Linda Fuller, the co-founders of Habitat for Humanity International. Another will be dedicated to six individuals who have each given 10 years of volunteer service to Team Clark Howard's Consumer Action Center.

Two of three new houses built with the support of Clark and Lane Howard in 2009 are located at 2058 and 2062 Lakewood Trail. [A third, the second "Two Williams House," was dedicated on March 14.] To date, 33 Atlanta Habitat houses have been sponsored through the generosity of Clark and Lane Howard and supportive partners. Cox Enterprises, Inc. in addition to its businesses: Cox Communications, Manheim, AutoTrader.com, The Atlanta Journal-Constitution, WSB –TV Channel 2 and its five local radio stations (WSB 750 AM, 97.1 The River, 95.5 The Beat, B98.5, Kiss 104.1), as well as The James M. Cox Foundation of Georgia and the James M. Cox Jr. Foundation are sponsors of the other two Atlanta Habitat homes being dedicated at 377 Wyndham Way and 2066 Lakewood Trail.

"It is particularly meaningful for Atlanta Habitat to honor the visionary co-founders of Habitat for Humanity International, Millard and Linda Fuller, at the dedication of a Clark Howard-sponsored home," noted Larrie Del Martin, Atlanta Habitat Executive Director. "Just as families and our entire community have benefited from the generosity and enthusiasm of Atlanta Habitat supporters like Clark and Lane Howard, so the enduring legacy of Millard and Linda Fuller's Habitat mission has reached around the world."

Directions to 2058, 2062 and 2066 Lakewood Trail and 377 Wyndham Way From I-75/85 Southbound:

- Take I-75/85 through downtown; exit at University Avenue, #244
- Turn LEFT at the end of the ramp onto University Avenue
- Keep RIGHT onto GA-54/McDonough Blvd
- Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto Jonesboro Rd SE. Travel 1.2 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto Browns Mill Road
- Take the 4th RIGHT onto Greendale Drive
- The 1st LEFT will be Lakewood Trail – the build sites are ahead on the right

Lakewood Trail and Wyndham Way are newly created streets in Lakewood Commons, and, as such, many online mapping programs will not recognize the street names or be able to provide accurate directions.
