



Below are the many ways to volunteer and fulfill the sweat equity requirement.

### Community

- We encourage community involvement. You may complete up to 10 sweat equity hours by attending your new neighborhood's Neighborhood Association, Neighborhood Planning Unit or Parent Teacher Association meetings.

### Family Services

### Home Construction

- Please note that you meet at the warehouse if you volunteer on the first day of a build unless otherwise noted. On the second through seventh days, report directly to the build site.
- Report by 8 a.m. and plan to stay until 4 p.m. If you are late, you may be turned away.
- A normal build schedule is every Saturday unless otherwise noted.
- **Be aware that space is limited at each build site and you may not bring more than 3 other people with you to a site.** If you are planning to bring volunteers to help you, please contact Matt Walenciak at 404-223-5180 ext. 113 to determine availability at least 3 days in advance. Remember to identify yourself as a homeowner.

### ReStore
