## **Atlanta Habitat, Catholic Church Sponsors and New Homeowner To Dedicate Second Pope Francis Home Saturday, Oct. 8**

After put the finishing touches on a second Atlanta Habitat for Humanity house built in honor of Pope Francis, volunteers will hold a dedication ceremony for the new homeowner, an Atlanta area preschool teacher, this Saturday.

The new four-bedroom two bath house was built over the last seven weeks with the help of volunteers and sponsors representing various catholic churches and affiliated groups. Inspired by the successful construction of the first house which was sponsored by an anonymous donor last year, the volunteers each contributed funds to build a second Pope Francis house with Atlanta Habitat. The new homeowner, who also helped to build the house as part of the Atlanta Habitat homebuyer requirements, and her three-year-old daughter will be present at the dedication to accept prayers, a Bible and good wishes.
