Lakiesha built her affordable home alongside dozens of Delta Air Lines volunteers last fall. "This is the biggest step in my life next to becoming a mom," she says while hammering away on the beams that will hold up the walls to her South River Gardens house. Before being accepted into the Atlanta Habitat first-time homebuyer program, Lakiesha and her three children rented a townhouse that often flooded, had high utility bills, and electrical outlets that routinely smoked. She worked hard to qualify for the program—completing the required sweat-equity hours and homeowner education classes while working as a billing specialist. At her home dedication, Lakiesha surprised her 6-year-old son, telling him: "This is our house. Mommy built this house, and you have your own room now. This is my best day ever!"
